

ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT



1. Developmental activities of the College



2. Teaching





3. Class room environment





4. Labs and Equipment





5. Library





7. Internet and WiFi





8. Sports and Cultural facilities



10. Subject Knowledge





Majority of the alumni members (98%) joyfully thank the college faculty members for being enriched with deep knowledge in their subject of study.

11. Industry- oriented projects







Around 53% of the alumni members commented that the special training classes enabled by our college are of high quality, as it aided students in achieving the high peaks of excellence. Student


support programs like 'Walk with a Scholar', remedial sessions and bridge courses helped the students to become thorough with their specific field of study.



14. Oncampus placement opportunities



15. Off Campus placements




