### Dr. Sabukkutty M.G

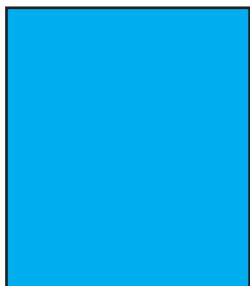

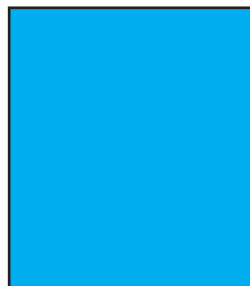

### **Dr. Joseph George**

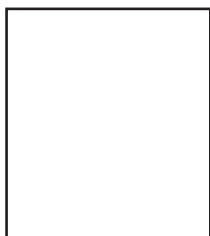

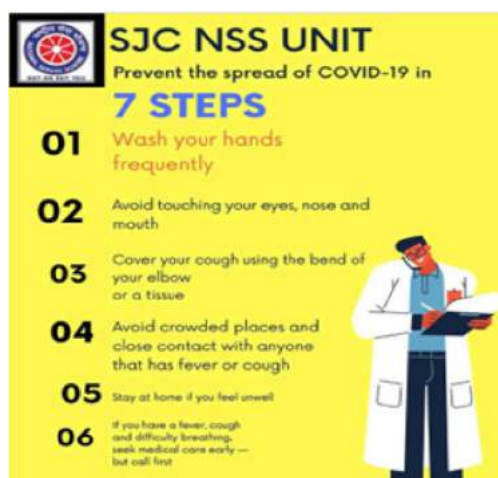
### iGot On-board Covid prevention Training

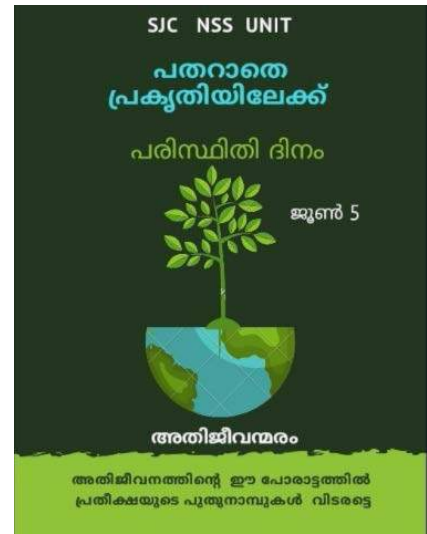


### International Nurses Day Observed

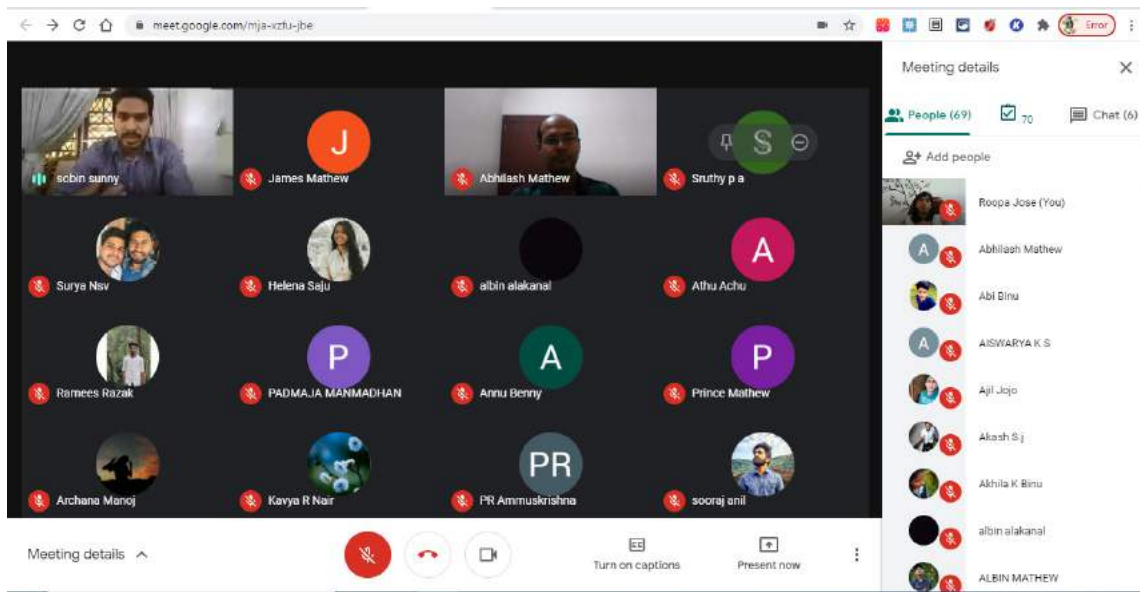
### World Environment day celebrations

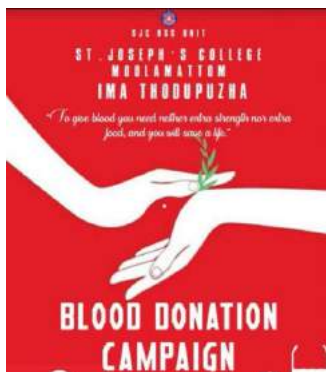
**NSS Day - September 24, celebrated**

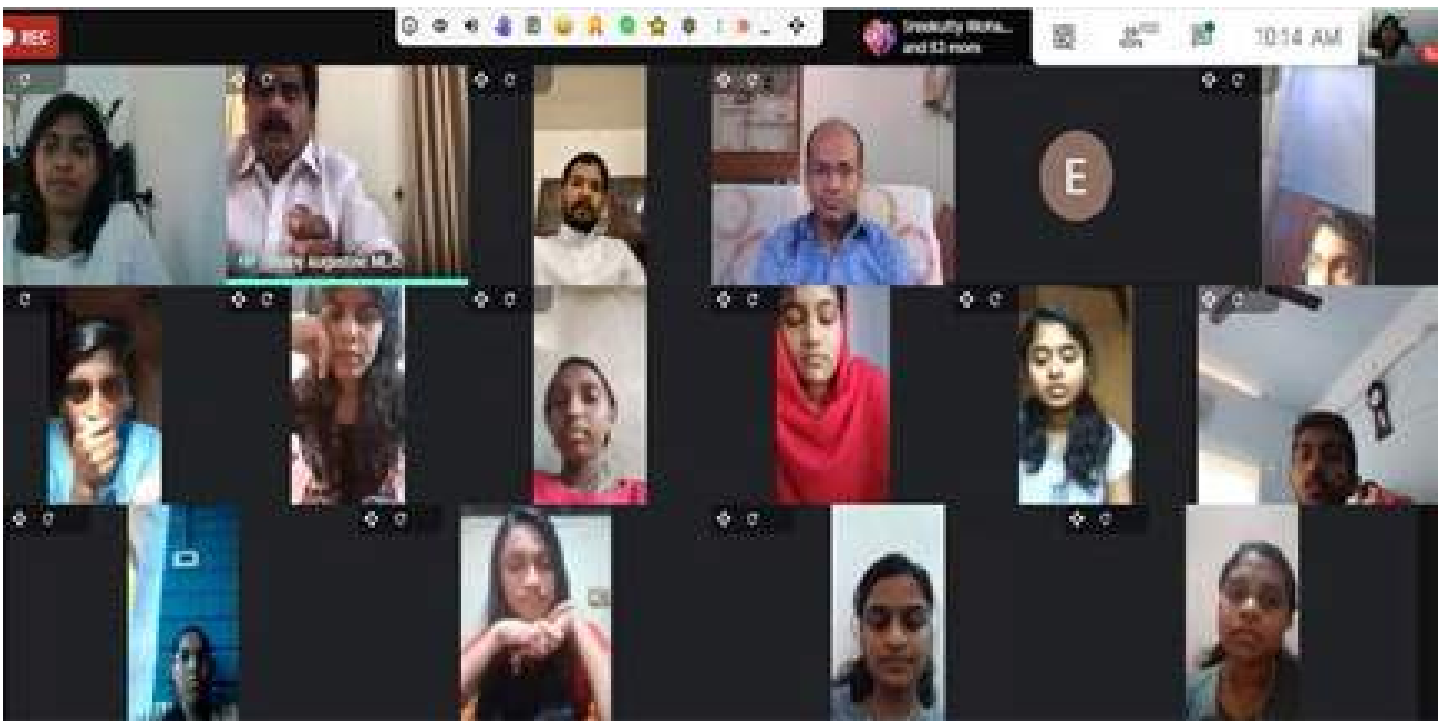
### First year Volunteers Orientation Programme
