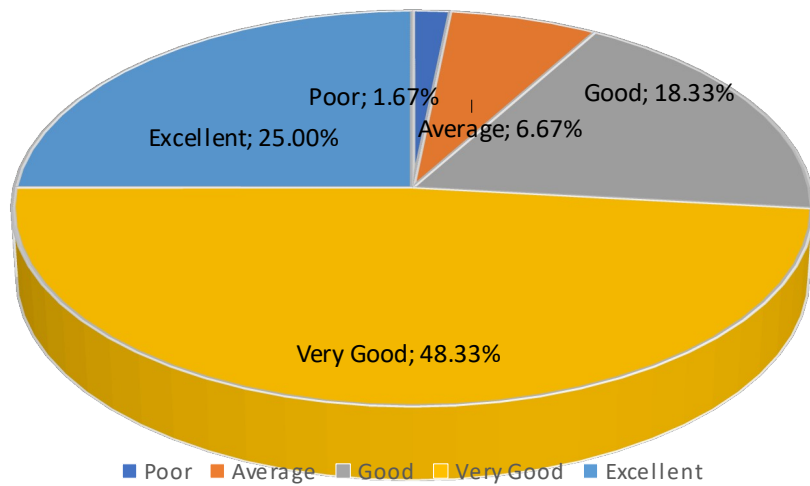
Note: 60 randomly selected samples were chosen such that alumni from all the departments were included in the sample.



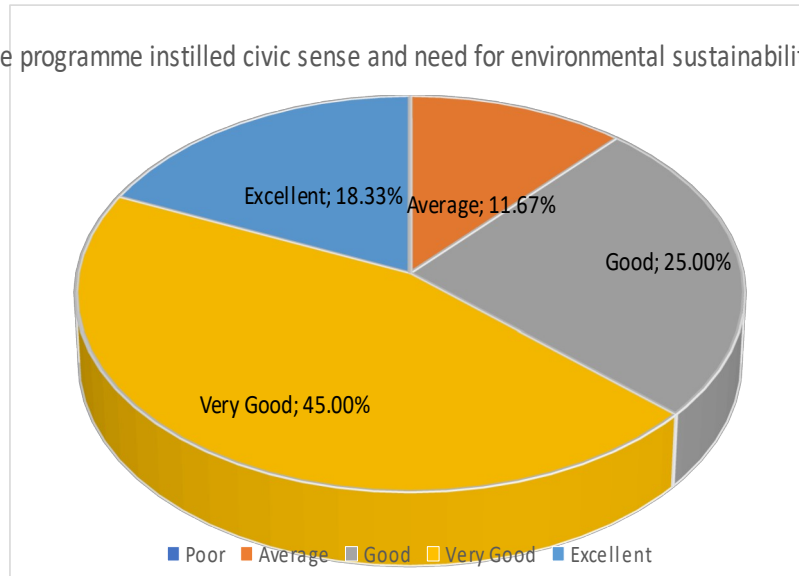

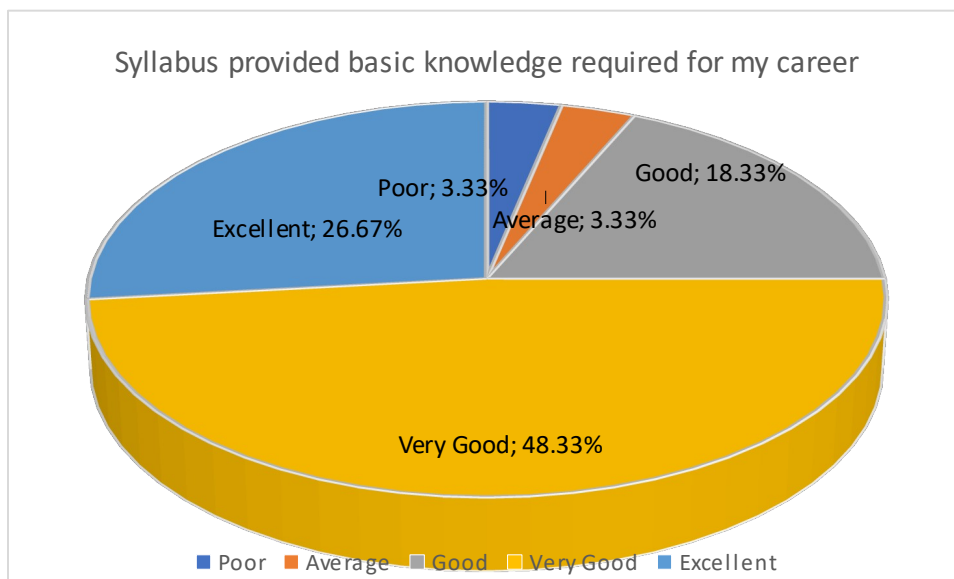
Degree programme improved my communication and critical thinking



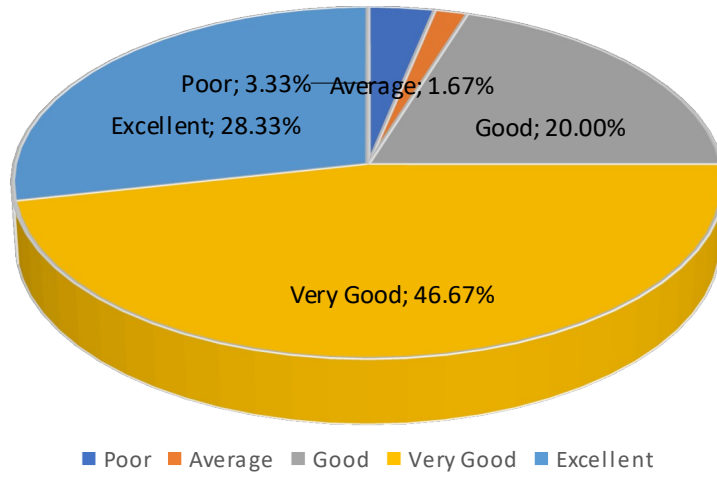
Degree programme instilled civic sense and need for environmental sustainability in me



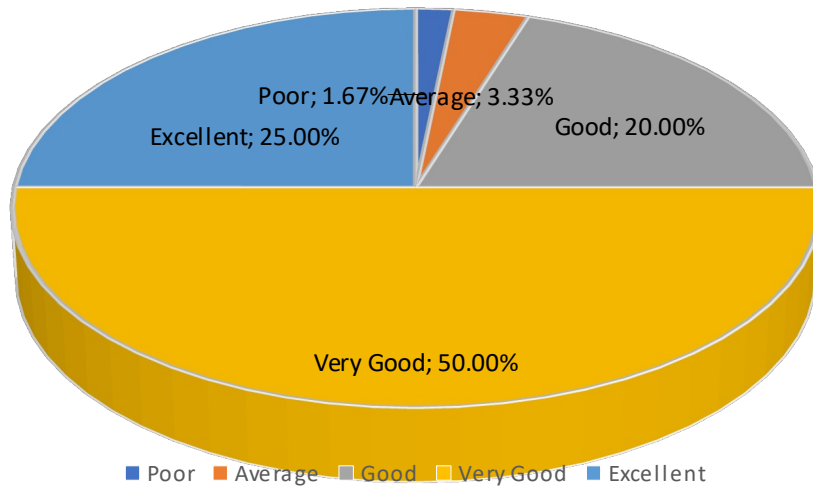

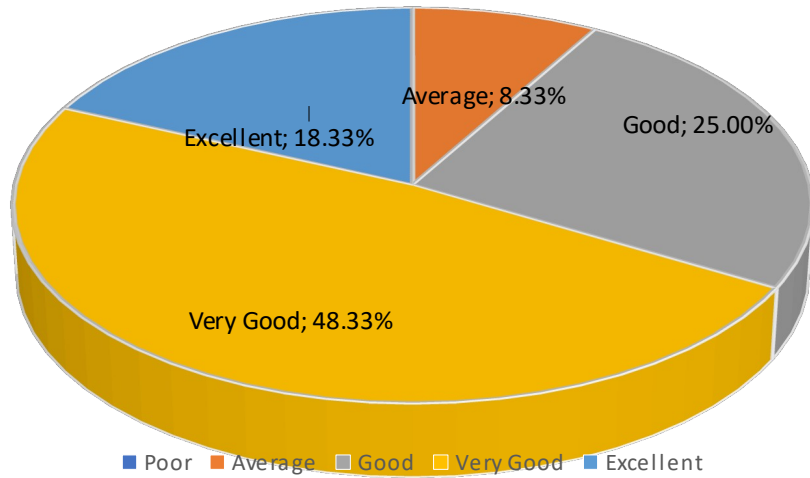
